- Objectives: Strengthen in-country supply chain systems, strengthen collaboration to improve commodity security, strengthen Global Health Security Agenda

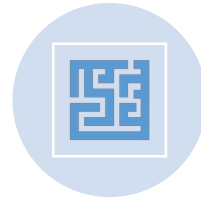

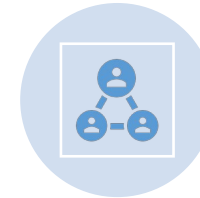
Why Governance?



How does our work fit within the broader objectives of the health system?



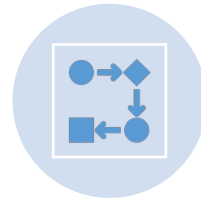
What problems are we trying to solve? How do we decide how to tackle them?



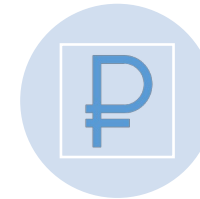
Who needs to be involved in what we're doing, and in what way?
